<p>What is the best thing about having a pool?</p>	<p>It just adds great beauty to your backyard. You can turn a normal backyard into an inviting paradise.</p>
<p>How often do you use your spa?</p>	<p>The best time to use the spa in my opinion is in the fall & winter months. After a long day, this is truly a stress reliever. We still use it in the summer months, but love it when it's cooler.</p>

It's really the perfect family gift, and a great way to bring families together. Every Sunday we cook-out, and just enjoy the pool—it's the best!</p>
<p>What is a good estimation of how much you spend in chemicals?</p>	<p>We have a salt pool. I can buy a 40 lb bag of salt at Sams for \$5.88 a bag. The salt pool has made pool ownership very affordable and easy to operate. About once a month, I will take my water to go get tested at Warehouse Pool Supply (A Free Service) that way I know all of my chemicals are set at the right levels. A salt pool requires a lot of acid. But, I Can Buy a case for under \$20 that lasts me a while.</p>
<p>Do you like your current purification, and why? (salt, chlorine, ozone)</p>	<p>I love it!! The water feels so smooth, you don't smell like bleach coming out of the pool, and it's better on your skin. Before we we're considering getting a pool, our pediatrician suggested that we get a salt water pool—it's better for the kids</p>
<p>What advice would you give us that would have helped the process go more smoothly?</p>	<p>You all did an outstanding job, and I loved that you would contact me by phone or e-mail and kept me posted through the whole process. Because, communication is key! so I could bring in good landscaping dirt.</p>
<p>If you were to build another pool, what would you do differently?</p>	<p>I would probably get a waterfall, or a beach entry type pool..those are neat! But, I love our big tanning ledge.</p>
